The rector of Samarkand State University named after Sh. Rashidov R. Khalmuradov delivered a welcoming speech to the participants of the meeting.

Prof. A. Yusupov (TUIT) in his speech noted that on the basis of the INMACOM project, master's programs in photonics and optical communication will be organized for the first time at four universities in Uzbekistan. 4 educational laboratories will be created in partner universities, cooperation between universities and industry will be developed.

Ulugbek Khodiyev (Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation) emphasized that the INMACOM project is important for Uzbekistan. With the implementation of the project, training will begin in the field of photonics and optical communications, which is very important at the current stage of development of the telecommunications industry in Uzbekistan. MHSSE will actively participate in the implementation of the project and dissemination of the results among other universities in Uzbekistan.

Presentation about SamSU and participation of SamSU in the INMACOM project - Soleev A. (SSU)

Samarkand State University is one of the oldest universities in Uzbekistan, has 14 faculties, trained more than 13000 students. The INMACOM project involves a team from the Faculty of Physics of the University. The importance of the implementation of the project was reported, the master's program in photonics and optical communications is of great importance to meet the needs of the labor market in the field of telecommunications in Uzbekistan.
